

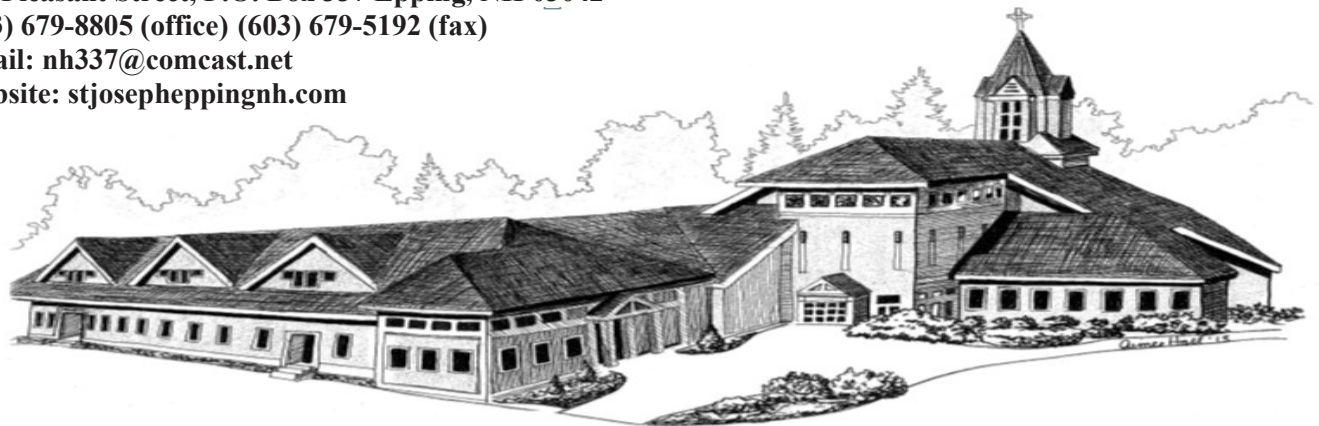

THE WOMEN OF GRACE FOUNDATIONAL STUDY GROUP

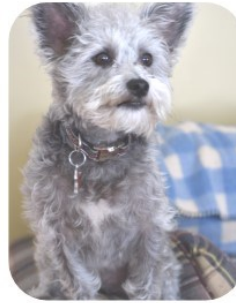
